May this year bring you boundless happiness, new adventures, and the same warmth you so generously share with others.

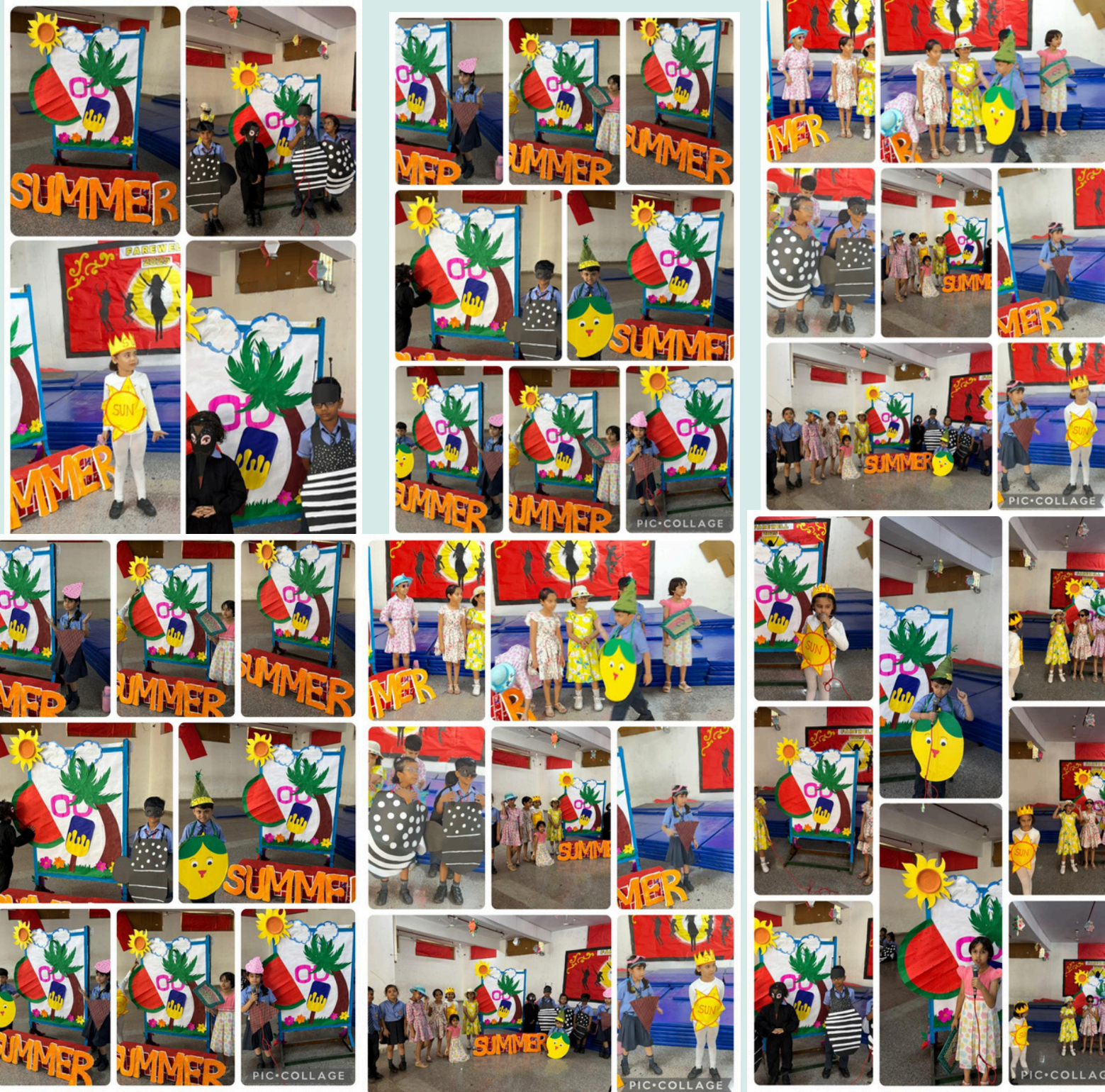

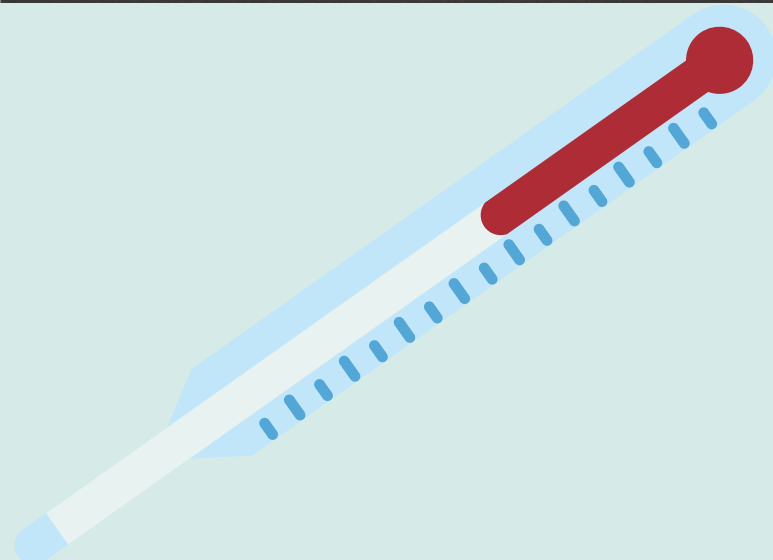
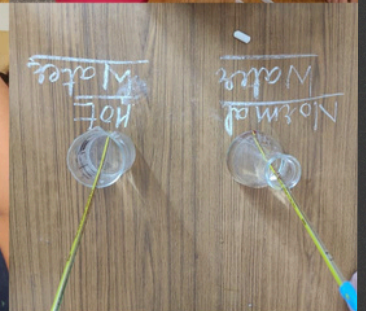

ACTIVITY: TO MEASURE THE TEMPERATURE USING LABORATORY THERMOMETER.



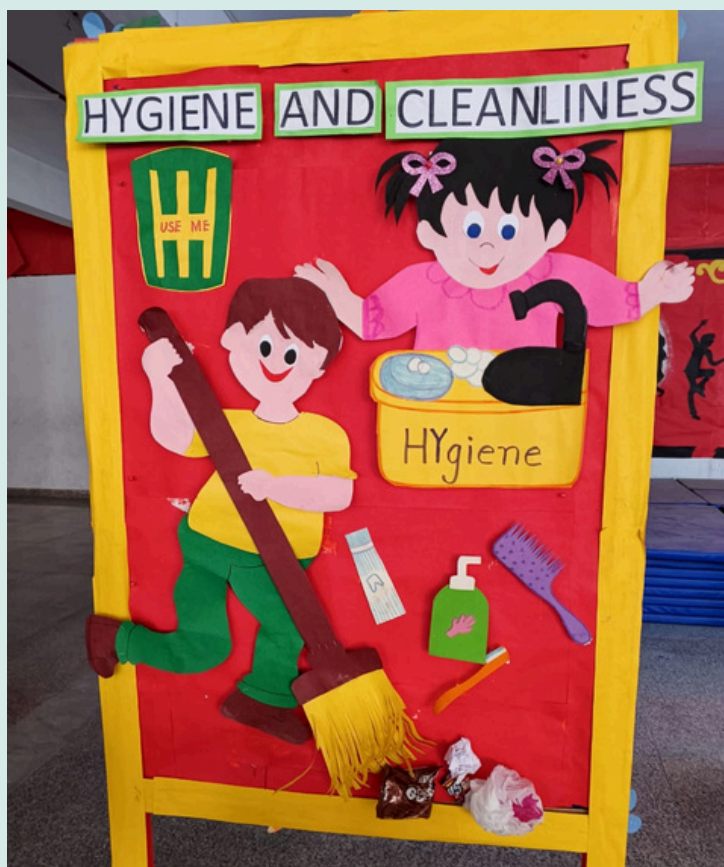


Such interactions play a vital role in nurturing a positive learning environment. We sincerely thank all the parents for their enthusiastic participation and continued involvement in their child's educational journey.





Operation Sindoor

Operation Sindoor was a military action launched by the Indian Armed Forces in response to the Pahalgam terrorist attack in which 26 people were killed. The operation targeted nine terrorist camps in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Jammu and Kashmir, focusing on infrastructure used to plan and conduct terrorist attacks against India. India's actions were described as precision strikes, aiming for a measured and non-escalatory response to the attack.
