



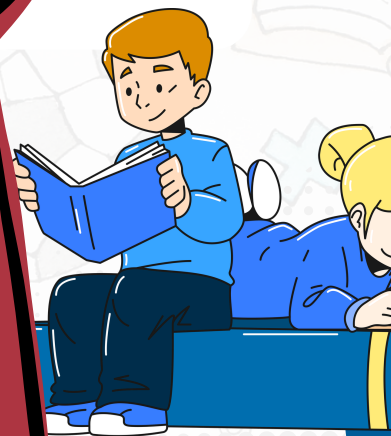

Students are encouraged to stay curious, disciplined, and strive for excellence.

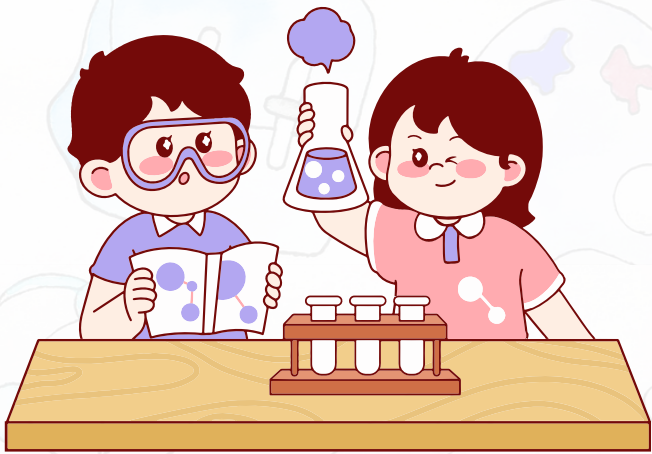
We thank parents for their support and appreciate our teachers for their dedication. Let us work together to make this year successful and meaningful.
