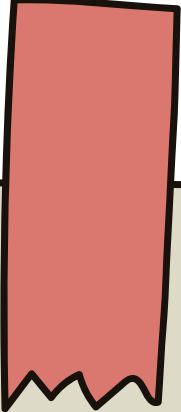
Inter-House Science Quiz Competition
